### APAC Rule 2.8 Discontinued programs

Where a program's teach out period extends beyond the end of its current accreditation cycle, the program is required to be accredited until all students have either completed or transitioned out. Where a program continues to be taught after the expiry of its accreditation, then the program will have a status of *Accreditation Revoked*. Any students completing the program while the program's accreditation has been revoked will be deemed to have graduated from a program that is *not accredited*.
